

THE TIMES OF THE NEW MOON מולדות

The *Molads* are announced by the *Gabai* at the time of the Blessing of the New Month, which takes place on the *Shabbos* before *Rosh Chodesh* (with the exception of the month of *Tishrei* whose *Molad* is not announced). The time for the *Molad* of each month is traditionally expressed in the days, minutes, and *Chalokim* after the hour. (A *Cheilek*, the smallest traditional measurement of the time, is 1/1080 of an hour, or 1/18 of a minute, which amounts to a little more than three seconds.) Thus, the traditional way of announcing the *Molad* for *MarCheshvan* would be to announce: "The *Molad* for *MarCheshvan* will be Tuesday, Oct. 9, 9:01 PM and 11 *Chalokim*." (The times of *Molad* is in Israel, see page 63).

and 15 *Chalokim*.

ADAR II: – Wednesday, March. 6,
12:41 PM and 16 *Chalokim*.

NISAN: – Friday, April 5, 1:25 AM
and 17 *Chalokim*.

IYAR: – Saturday, May 4, 2:10 PM.

SIVAN: – Monday, June 3, 2:54 AM
and 1 *Chelek*.

TAMUZ: – Tuesday, July 2, 3:38 PM
and 2 *Chalokim*.

AV: – Thursday, Aug, 1, 4:22 AM. and
3 *Chalokim*.

ELUL: – Friday, Aug. 30, 5:06 PM and
4 *Chalokim*.

Candle lighting listings for Shabbos
and Yom Tov are 20 minutes before
sunset and all time listings inside and at
the end of the Luach are Standard Time.
For Daylight Savings Time add 1 hour.
